BAAQMD REGULATION 9, RULE 7 UPDATE

FACT: Boilers with a rated heat input of 20 MMBtu/hr to < 75 MMBtu/hr must comply with 9 ppm NOx, effective January 1, 2012. Boilers with a rated heat input of 75 MMBtu/hr or more must comply with 5 ppm NOx, effective January 1, 2012*.

FACT: In the long term, air emission regulations in the Bay Area may change. If this occurs, boilers performing at higher NOx limits will need to be upgraded with new equipment in order to be in compliance with new regulations.

FACT: NOx levels of less than 5 ppm are predicted after 2015. A selective catalytic reduction (SCR) technology solution helps ensure that your equipment will be "future compliance ready".
